Finn Camp as a Co-operative

- ▶ Founded in 1925 by Finnish Americans in Detroit
- Longest-running co-operative in the state of Michigan (or the USA?)
- On the Register of National Historic Places
- Approx. 185 members.
 - Work 24 hours each year
 - Can vote in membership meetings (2x / year)
 - Pay association dues & taxes (\$450-500 / year)
 - Can own a camp & use facilities
 - ► Can reserve facilities for private events





Finn Camp – Physical

- >100 acres in Wixom, Michigan
- Exclusive access to Sun Lake, boat access to Loon Lake
- Sauna house, dance hall, clubroom (club liquor license), ravintola
- Athletic fields Softball, basketball, pickle ball, horseshoes, bocce ball
- 2 Common bathrooms for ~150 camps
- Caretaker house, equipment shed, pole barn

Finn Camp Organization – Board of Directors

Seven BOD members – President, Vice-President, Treasurer,
 Secretary, Works Administrators (x3)

Elected to 2-year terms, alternate years (3,4), maximum four years consecutive

- ▶ Meet 1x/month in winter, 2x/month in summer
- Manage caretaker & beach manager
- Manage finances and budget: ~\$250,000 / year
- Enforce Blue Book rules
- Organize membership meetings
 - Annual Meeting (April): elections, budget
 - Semi-Annual Meeting (October)

- Articles of Incorporation define DFCSCA
- By-Laws:
 - Membership
 - Board of Directors
 - ▶ Fiscal Management
 - Property / Liquidation
- Rules:
 - Work hours, reservations
 - Rules: general, beach, sauna, camps
 - Committees
 - Fees & Assessments





Finn Camp Organization – Committees

- Bar manage club liquor license, host events
- Recreation children's activities
- Future Planning major physical investments
- ▶ Woods maintain woodlands
- Cultural host cultural events
- Kitchen maintain summer kitchen
- Investment manage endowment
- Events committees: Juhannus, Winterfest, Finn Fest, St. Urho's
- Scholarship committee college scholarships
- Many other committees, 23 in all



History

- ▶ 1925: Association formed. 1st sauna house
- ▶ 1927: Dance Hall constructed
 - Lower floor of dance hall used as ice house, general store
- ▶ 1940s: Electricity for camps
- ▶ 1940s 1950s: Weekly dances in dance hall
- ▶ 1960s lower floor of dance hall converted to club room
- ~1970: neighborhood land sold to create endowment for major projects
- ▶ 1970s first Detroit Finn Fest
- ▶ 1980s 3rd (present) sauna house constructed
- 2000s Loon Lake boat launch
- 2017 Edwin Elkhill scholarship fund
