- Application deadline is September 1st of a given year, by email only at <u>scholarships@finncamp.org</u>
- The packet will be submitted in its entirety and will include last year's school transcripts, letter of recommendation, essay, a copy of your workhours card and a photo of yourself of your choosing. Combine your photo and essay on an 8.5 x 11" page.
- As required, the scholarship committee will verify the following: You are a D.F.C.S.C.A. member or member's child in good standing for the past two years, you are or intend to be a full-time college/university student and your GPA is at least 3.0.
- By signing the application, you give the committee permission to seek verification of these points, as well as permission for the D.F.C.S.C.A. to use your essay and photo for display at Camp events and/or publication in the Finn Camp Newsletter.
